

# We Will Remember Them...



In History, the children will discover the key events which identify this incredible period of history. 2018 marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of the First World War and during this project the children will learn about the bravery of the soldiers and civilians who gave their lives for us. The children will learn about the roles of different groups of people during the war and understand their contribution.

In PE, the children will continue to learn the skills needed for invasion games however this half term we will apply these in the game of football. Year 3 will learn how to attack and defend a ball whilst working effectively within a team.

In RE, the children will be learning about the concept of angels. We will consider what Christians believe angels to be and their role within the Christmas story.

In Art, we will be using tissue paper to create a three-dimensional poppy which will form part of a whole school piece of artwork.

In Maths, the children will be learning how to calculate multiplication and division using a formal written method. Year 3 will also learn how to find equivalent fractions, how to find fractions of number and how to count in tenths. We will also be improving our understanding of 3D shape and angles too. Please keep working hard to learn the multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

In English, Year 3 will be using their historical learning to inspire their writing. We will be developing our researching skills and then using these facts to write a non-fiction report about the military vehicles used during WW1. We will use the powerful emotions evoked from this project to inspire some diary writing and poetry filled with imagery.
