



In **RE** we are asking the key question; What do Christians believe God is like? We will be exploring the parable of the Prodigal Son and its meaning.

This term in **Science**, we will be learning to name, identify and classify a variety of common animals into groups: mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish and birds. We will also identify animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

In **Computing**, the children will be creating animated stories using Purple Mash.

Our PE day continues to be on Thursday. The children will be learning the basics of parkour and develop their sending and receiving skills in the playground.

In **Geography**, we will be answering our key enquiry question: Are all parts of the world the same?

We will be exploring hot and cold climates **and how a country's** position in relation to the Equator can affect its climate.

In **Maths**, we will continue to learn about place value for numbers up to 100. We will then introduce numbers 11-19. We will continue to practise counting in 2s and 10s and also be introducing counting in 5s.

In **English** this term we will be **writing a visitor story based on, 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'**. We will also write a report about an animal following our visit to the wildlife park. We will be learning about exclamation marks and encouraging the children to add suffixes including s, es, ed, and ing to words.

In **D&T** this term, we will be creating animal collages. The children will be practising cutting and joining techniques.
