

Geography

This term, we will explore England and Mexico. We will launch our learning by finding out about where in the world Mexico is located, the oceans it coasts and its main human features, including its major exports and harbours. We will also discover the physical features of Mexico, including its coastal plains, temperate highlands and mountains and discuss how these compare to those in the United Kingdom. We will research Mexico's Chetumal, comparing its harbour and features to Poole and the United Kingdom.

DT

We will be exploring Mexican food culture and comparing it with that of the UK. This will entail researching food and nutrition and creating some Mexican specialties, including guacamole.

English

This term, we will be exploring the book 'The Rainbow Weaver' by Linda Elovitz Marshall and Elisa Chavarri. This book is set in a neighbouring country of Mexico called Guatemala. We will be reading this story and looking carefully at its use of similes to enhance description and its use of speech. The children will then be writing their own retelling of the story with their own description.

PE

We will be continuing our unit on Parkour and developing the skills we learnt last term.

R.E

In R.E, we are answering the question, "What do Christians believe God is like?" We will learn that Christians believe God is loving, forgiving, kind and fair. We will explore different stories that show these Christian beliefs as well as discussing whether they can learn anything from the stories for themselves.

Maths

In Maths, we will be moving on to our unit with a focus on measure. The children will be introduced to measuring lengths and heights in cm and m and how to use the four operations to answer questions about length/height. The children will also cover measuring mass in grams and kilograms. Towards the end of the term, we will be moving onto fractions and starting with finding a half, quarters and thirds.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be starting our unit on financial education. We will be using the story 'Milo's Money' to support our learning on savings, spending and sharing.

Science

In science, we will be learning all about how different animals are adapted to live in different environments. We will also be learning about habitats and how they are key to survival.
