



Computing

Children will create concept maps to represent human and physical features of Brazil. They'll also focus on e-safety and develop their digital skills with a unit from Purple Mash.

English

We will be reading *Kensuke's Kingdom* by Michael Morpurgo, using it to inspire a range of writing, including diary entries and haiku poetry. Pupils will also explore environmental issues such as deforestation through creative writing.

Reading

Children will read *Kensuke's Kingdom*, focusing on comprehension, vocabulary, and deeper understanding of themes and character development.

PSHE

We'll cover a range of topics around transition and drugs and medication safety.

French

Children will continue to develop their French language skills around ordering an ice cream.

Geography

We'll compare the human and physical geography of Dorset and Rio de Janeiro, exploring topics like climate, deforestation, settlements, and urbanisation. Children will also use maps and six-figure grid references to build their locational knowledge.

Maths

This term's focus is on angles, shape and decimals—understanding place value, ordering, comparing, and applying decimals in real-life contexts. We will also be looking at negative numbers and time.

PE

Sports Week will be a highlight this term! Pupils will take part in various sporting activities to promote fitness, teamwork, and fun.

Art

Inspired by Sally Winter, Claude Monet, and J.M.W. Turner, children will explore observational painting, colour palettes, and techniques for capturing landscapes.

Science

Our science topic is *Living Things and Their Habitats*. Children will study life cycles, animal reproduction, and learn how different species grow and survive in their environments.
