Term 1

Autumn 1

Our first topic in EYFS is 'All About Me' and we will be learning all about our new school, class, families and friends.

As we settle into school life, we will be exploring our school environment, developing our independence and getting to know the school routine.

Over the coming weeks, we will be understanding and recognising how we can display different feelings and emotions. We will read 'The Colour Monster'. This book will complement our learning through 'Let's Explore'.



The children will bring home reading books once we have got to know the children over the first few weeks.

Through Tapestry, we will share all the wonderful learning that the children will explore during their first term at St. James'.



Let's Explore

Our continuous provision will reflect learning opportunities created by 'The Colour Monster' & child led themes/ideas. These will incorporate the different areas of learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage.



Phonics

The children will begin our new Phonics scheme 'Little Wandle'. They will begin with Phase 2, which are the initial sounds. They will progress to blending simple words. The children will also be bringing home a reading book after the first couple of weeks.

Maths

We will be using 'NCETM' planning to supplement the learning during Maths. Sorting, matching and recognising patterns within objects and numbers will form the first part of maths. We will begin to learn and sing lots of number rhymes songs. We will then move onto counting and ordering numbers.
