<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Design</u></p> <p>-Invent your own imaginary creature. What is it called? (it could be a mixture of 2 animals, e.g giraffe and elephant = girafant!) Where does it live? What does it eat? How does it move. Draw and label a picture of it.</p> <p>-Design your own zoo. Draw a plan of it and label the areas where you would keep the different animals.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Create</u></p> <p>-Draw or paint a picture of a creature of your choice.</p> <p>-Make a collage of an underwater creature using materials you find on a beach.</p> <p>-Using playdough, clay or plasticine, make a model of an animal that lives in the jungle.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Visit</u></p> <p>-Visit a wildlife centre/zoo/farm and make a list of all the creatures you see there. Take photos and try to name each animal and what group it belongs to. (mammal, amphibian, reptile, bird or fish)</p> <p>-Visit an animal sanctuary and write sentences to explain how they care for the animals.</p> <p>-Go to a pet shop and look at the animals and what they need to be cared for.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Research</u></p> <p>-Choose a creature that lives on the land or sea and make a fact file about it. What does it look like? (draw and label a picture of it.) Where does it live? What does it eat? What interesting facts can you find out about it?</p> <p>-Choose an animal that lives in another country and write 5 facts about it.</p> <p>-Find out about a mythical creature and read a story about it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Write</u></p> <p>-Write an ABC of all the different creatures you can name with each letter of the alphabet.</p> <p>-Write a “What am I? poem about a creature of your choice by giving clues to the reader</p> <p>e.g <i>I have 2 legs. I live in a tree. I have feathers. I eat worms. I fly.
