

English

In English we will focus on narrative writing in the first person, reaffirming our knowledge of sentence fundamentals and word types. We will seek inspiration for our narratives from various texts, including Rainbow Weaver, which is set in Mexico's neighbouring country Guatemala. Then, we will move our focus to non-fiction non-chronological report writing, where we delve deeper into Mexico's heritage and culture to create our own Mexico fact files.

Geography

This term we will explore England and Mexico. We will launch our learning by finding out about where in the world Mexico is located, the oceans it coasts and its main human features, including its biggest exports and harbours. We will also discover the physical features of Mexico, including its coastal plains, temperate highlands and mountains and discuss how these compare to those in the United Kingdom. We will research Mexico's Chetumal, comparing its harbour and features to Poole and the United Kingdom. As part of our fantastic finish, we will have a Mexican Fiesta with traditional Mexican food, games and dancing!

Maths

In Maths we will be learning to tell the time, starting with on the hour, half past and quarter past/to. Once that is mastered, we will look at 5 and 10 past/to. We will move onto statistics, looking at how we gather and present numerical data and information. Alongside these areas of Maths, we will also be consolidating our fractions and shape learning.
