Dear Parents/Carers

Holiday Fines

Attendance at school is crucial for children's learning and even attendance of 90% equates to half a day absence per week. This in turn equates to 4 weeks absence in an academic year. If a child persistently had 90% attendance over the course of their education they would have been absent for a whole year of their education.

Under pressure from new Government guidance and BCP, we are having to introduce Fixed Penalty Fines for holidays taken in term time. Whilst we completely understand the cultural and family benefits of a holiday, these should be taken in school holiday time to avoid disrupting or missing learning.

From Monday 15th April (start of the Summer term), any unauthorised holidays in term time will be subject to a fine of £60 per parent, rising to £120 per parent if the fine is not paid within 21 days. In September, in line with Government guidance, the fine will rise to £80 per parent. The money does not go to the school and the process is administered by the local authority.
